1. Bachelor of Business Administration & Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting Programs Change Requests & Proposal. Log No. 5838. Reviewed by UCRC (S. Bells, Chair). Contact person R. Jones (jonesr@triton.uog.edu). *Distributed to UCRC on 19 January 2019.*

Background: This request is to change the requirements for the Bachelor of Business Administration (BBA) degree and to change the requirements for the Bachelor of Business Administration in Accounting (BBAA) degree. This also includes 6 new courses (BA 131—Introduction to Information Management, BA 335—Cyber Security and Cloud Services, BA/PA 347 Leadership and Collaboration in Organizations and Society, BA 386—Logistics and Supply Chain Management, BA 431—Topics in Management of

Technology and Innovation, and BA 483—Business Professional and Career Development), as well as substantive change to 1 existing course (BA 482—Business Service Learning). There are also non-substantive changes to courses that are not the purview of the Faculty Senate.

Review Process: This request has received the following endorsements: Program & Division Chair on 18 January 2018, the College AAC and Dean of SBPA on 19 January 2018.

1. Intellectual Property: Patents, Inventions, and Copyright Policy. Log No. 5798. Reviewed by SCIE (K. Smith, Chair). Contact person D. McKay (dmckay@triton.uog.edu). *Distributed to SCIE on 13 November 2017.*

Background: This request is to update, expand, and improve UOG's Intellectual Property Policy. The new policy increases the potential share of the "creator" from 33% to 40–45% of the royalty income and provides more comprehensive guidance on handling intellectual property issues, including the composition of the Innovation Policy Board.

Review Process: This request was created by an ad hoc committee of faculty and administrators (13 February 2018). It was reviewed by the Research Council (12 February 2018) and the Administrative Council (12 February 2018). The RFK Academic Affairs Committee reviewed the Copyright section (13 February 2018).

Background: This request is to change the current Communications Program from 2 tracks to 4 tracks (Communication Studies, Public Relations, Journalism, and Digital Cinema & Media). In conjunction with this change, the credit hours required for the program would be increased from 45 credit hours to 51 credit hours and the courses required for each track are defined.

3. Course Retake Policy for Undergraduate. Log No. 5817. Reviewed by SCIE (K. Smith, Chair). Contact person M. Vuki (vukim@triton.uog.edu). *Distributed to SCIE on 19 January 2018.*

Background: This request is to add to the allowable situations in which a student may retake a class to include classes for which a student has received a grade between C– and B+. Students who wish to retake a course under these circumstances must receive approval of the program and the Dean of the college that offers the course. Note however, that students who are taking the course for the first time will be given priority. If a course is repeated, the course (and original grade) will appear on the student's transcripts, but only the last grade achieved for the course will be included in the student's GPA.

Background: This request is to allow students to repeat courses for which they have earned a C– or less. The current policy only allows students who have earned a D, F, or W to repeat a course. However, with the change in the UOG grading system to include +/- grades, a C– is below (GPA 1.70) the GPA necessary to remain in good academic standing (GPA 2.00).

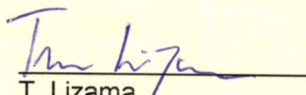
