



Foundations: Online Teaching Certificate

The Foundations: Online Teaching Certificate (OTC1) is a 20-hour, asynchronous professional development course designed for faculty, staff, and student teaching assistants who are striving to grow and sustain online learning at the University of Guam.



This course will be available beginning **August 12th, 2024**. It is a free, open-enrollment, open-schedule course, which means there are no restrictions on the number of participants and there are no set deadlines. Participants are encouraged to work through the curriculum at a pace that works best for their schedules and learning goals. Participants who successfully meet course requirements will earn their Foundations badge (i.e. certificate).



This course was co-created by Dr. Andrea Sant, Dr. Dean Olah, and Dr. Merissa Bunton. It is the first core course in the I Meyeng: UOG-Certified Online Teacher program.
