History

The I Meyeng UOG-Certified Online Teacher program began in March 2020 as an online teaching resource hub during the pandemic.

UOG's Online Teaching team — led by Director Andrea Sant; Merissa Bunton, Instructional Design Coach; and Dean Olah, Course Development Specialist later developed the certification program to help faculty gain new skills and professionalize their online classrooms.

The team received a Triton Team Award in December 2021 for the program's success.



Overview

A Chamorro word for "expert," the I Meyeng designation is earned by individuals who complete the full program of online teaching professionalization. The approximately 100-training hours include three (20-hour) core courses and three (6-8-hour) workshops.

UOG-OTC program curriculum includes courses and workshops focused on Moodle skill-building and online teaching bestpractice scholarship. Courses build from beginner level to more advanced skills as participants explore topics such as how to redesign face-to-face curriculum for online delivery and how to make the most of our learning management system, Moodle.



Certificates Completed

To date (Aug. 2024), 528 course and workshop certificates have been earned by UOG faculty, staff, and students in the *I Meyeng* UOG-Certified Online Teacher program.
