

Brown and Caldwell Scholarship Program

Scholarship Program Overview

Brown and Caldwell Scholarship Program is designed to increase students' interest in the engineering and environmental professions and to support them in defining career goals while attending the University of Guam (UOG). The program will award a \$1,000 scholarship each to five (5) selected students.

Eligibility

Candidates for the Brown and Caldwell Scholarship Program must:

- ✓ Be a United States citizen, permanent resident, or citizens of the Republic of Palau, Federated States of Micronesia, or Republic of the Marshall Islands.
- ✓ Be a full-time student enrolled in the University of Guam and will also be enrolled for the following school year.
- ✓ Have a declared major in engineering for undergraduate study (to include the pre-engineering program) or pursue a graduate degree in environmental science.
- ✓ Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent on a 5.0 scale).

Application Process

Candidates must submit:

- ✓ A completed application form.
- ✓ An essay of 250 words or less on "My future career goals in (engineering or environmental science)."
- ✓ Two written recommendations, with at least one from a UOG official (e.g., advisor, professor, etc.).
- ✓ Academic advisor's name, phone number, and e-mail address.
- ✓ An official transcript of your academic record.

Award

- Total Award - \$25,000
- Scholarship Program Award Period – Five years beginning with the 2015-2016 class and ending with the 2019-2020 class
- Awards
 - Four \$1,000 scholarship awards for undergraduate students
 - One \$1,000 scholarship award for a graduate student

2018 Scholarship Program Process

- UOG will announce the Scholarship Program to the Guam community in June 2018.
- The UOG Scholarship Committee will accept and review scholarship applicants and provide recommendation for the five awardees (with alternates) based on the applicant's eligibility.
 - Upon announcement of the Scholarship Program, UOG will begin accepting applications until August 17, 2018.
 - UOG Scholarship Committee will review and recommend awardees to Brown and Caldwell, August 20 – 22, 2018.
- Brown and Caldwell (BC) will approve the awardees.
 - BC will review recommended awardees, August 23 – 24, 2018.
 - BC will approve awardees, August 24, 2018.
- BC will issue scholarship checks (by August 24, 2018) to UOG for distribution to the awardees.
- UOG will announce the Scholarship Program awardees and will issue funds for the scholarship recipient.
 - Ceremony will be held at later date. (Ceremony will coincide with Pacific Area Manager's visit whom will be in attendance, along with additional Guam office attendees).
