

## NAWIC Guam Scholarship Program

### **Scholarship Program Overview**

NAWIC Guam Scholarship Program is designed to increase students' interest in the architectural, engineering, and construction professions and to support them in defining career goals while attending the University of Guam (UOG). The program will award a \$1,000 scholarship each to two (2) selected students.

### Eligibility

Candidates for the NAWIC Guam Scholarship Program must:

- Be a United States citizen, permanent resident, or citizens of the Republic of Palau, Federated States of Micronesia, or Republic of the Marshall Islands.
- Be a full-time student enrolled in the University of Guam and will also be enrolled for the following school year.
- ✓ Have a declared major in architectural or engineering for undergraduate study (to include the pre-engineering program).
- ✓ Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent on a 5.0 scale).

### **Application Process**

Candidates must submit:

- ✓ A completed application form.
- ✓ Academic advisor's name, phone number, and e-mail address.
- An unofficial transcript of your academic record showing your cumulative GPA.
  Please note that NAWIC Guam will confirm your GPA with the University of Guam prior to scholarship award.

### **About NAWIC**

The National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) originally began as Women in Construction of Fort Worth, Texas. Sixteen women working in the construction industry founded it in 1953. Knowing that women represented only a small fraction of the construction industry, the founders organized NAWIC to create a support network. Women in Construction of Fort Worth was so successful that it gained its national charter in 1955 and became the National Association of Women in Construction. Today, NAWIC provides its members with opportunities for professional development, education, networking, leadership training, public service and more.



# **NAWIC Guam Scholarship Program Specifics**

### Award

- Awards
  - Two \$1,000 scholarship awards for undergraduate students

### 2018 Scholarship Program Process

- UOG will announce the Scholarship Program to the Guam community.
- The UOG Scholarship Committee will accept and review scholarship applicants and provide recommendation for the two awardees (with alternates) based on the applicant's eligibility.
  - UOG Scholarship Committee will review and recommend awardees to NAWIC Guam, August 24, 2018.
- NAWIC Guam will approve the awardees.
  - NAWIC Guam will review and approve recommended awardees, August 27, 2018.
- NAWIC Guam will issue scholarship checks (by August 30, 2018) to UOG for distribution to the awardees.
- UOG will announce the Scholarship Program awardees and will issue funds for the scholarship recipient.
  - Ceremony will be held on August 30, 2018 during NAWIC Guam's 2018 Leadership Conference at the Pacific Star Resort & Spa.
  - The two scholarship recipient will be invited to attend the 1.5 day leadership conference to learn and network with community and industry leaders.
