

ADVANCE HIGH SCHOOL TUITION CREDIT CHECKLIST REQUIREMENTS

Advance High School Enrollment Program is an agreement with the University of Guam that provides the opportunity for high school students to earn Advance High School high school and college credits. This is to prepare High School students to better meet the requirements for college success. The University of Guam is chartered to provide college education to those who meet the requirements to apply and for those high school students within one year of high school graduation.

University of Guam		
EN109 Introduction to College Composition		
MA110 Finite Mathematics		
MA161A/B or MA165 College Algebra & Trigonometry or Pre-Calculus		

NOTES:

- 1. High School credit will NOT be given to students enrolled in MA085 courses at the University of Guam.
- 2. *Interim equivalent course until the development and approval of a GDOE Pre-Calculus class.
- 3. All Advance High School Enrollment courses successfully completed by GDOE students will be treated as honors courses and grades received will be weighted.
- 4. Articulation of courses will only be accepted by GDOE as GDOE courses. GDOE courses are not applicable to UOG.

Advance High School Enrollment Eligibility:

To be eligible for the Advance High School Enrollment Program, the student must:

- be in senior standing with 3.0 GPA;
- complete Advance High School Enrollment form;
- submit a school recommendation certifying student's grade level;
- must place at least in EN109 and MA085

How to apply:

There are published deadlines to submit your applications for each specific semester. Applications are available online to download. You may also visit the Admissions and Records Office located in the Field House, to pick up one. Before submitting your applications, you must pay a nonrefundable application fee of \$49.00 at the Cashier. The checklist below will help you complete your application.

Application checklist:

Are you within one year of your high school graduation?

Did you complete the Advance High School Enrollment Consent Form? (page 2 of this handout)

Do you have a cumulative GPA of 3.00 indicated on your preliminary transcript?

- Do you have your school counselor/principal's recommendation letter?
- Does it indicate that you are a senior and your GPA is at least 3.00?

□ Take the Math and/or English Placement Tests. Did you place into EN109 and MA085?

Did you turn in your most recent class schedule?
