Alumna and businesswoman Annmarie Muna to address graduates

More than 240 graduates are expected to receive their degrees on Sunday, Dec. 22, at the University of Guam's Fanuchånan 2019 Commencement Ceremony, starting at 2 p.m. in the Calvo Field House.

Annmarie T. Muna, a licensed independent insurance broker and general manager for AM Insurance, will deliver the commencement address. Muna graduated with top honors from the University of Guam in 1983, earning her bachelor's as a double major in management and business administration while working as an insurance clerk.
