Cadet Kortney Camacho takes command of UOG's ROTC battalion

The University of Guam Army ROTC program will hold its Cadet Battalion Change of Command Ceremony at 8 a.m. this Friday at the UOG Calvo Field House. The event is open to the public.

Cadet Battalion Commander Brendan Santos will hand over the leadership of the battalion to Cadet Kortney Camacho. Santos is a graduate of George Washington High School and is majoring in political science, while Camacho is a graduate of Guam High School and is majoring in criminal justice.

The Change of Command Ceremony is a time-honored tradition in military services that signifies the ordered transition of leadership duties in military units. At the



University of Guam, the Cadet Battalion executes a change of command every semester, and every UOG ROTC graduate has the opportunity to serve in numerous leadership positions throughout their time in the program. It allows the cadets to put into practice the leadership lessons and theories that they learn in the classroom.
