UOG announces new faculty and administrators

The University of Guam announces 11 new full-time faculty members and three new administrators who have joined the university this academic year. They are as follows:

Faculty:



Jose Edgardo L. Aban, Ph.D.

Aban joined the College of Liberal Arts and Social Sciences in August as an assistant professor of geography. Prior to joining UOG, he served as vice president and division head of the plantation monitoring and planning division of Sinarmas Agribusiness and Food in Jakarta. He also previously taught environmental studies and geography as a senior lecturer at the Universiti of Brunei Darussalam. He holds a bachelor's in biology and a master's in remote sensing from the University of the Philippines as well as a doctorate in remote sensing from Chiba University in Japan.



Natalie M. Capacci, MSN, FNP-C

Capacci joined the School of Health in February as an instructor of nursing. In her 16 years as a nurse, five years were spent with the U.S. Navy Nurse Corps, where she deployed to Southeast Asia and had a port call in Guam.
