Bert Quinata, Refrigeration Mechanic I, Tom San Nicolas, Maintenance Worker, and Paul Cruz, Maintenance Custodian each completed coursework and on-the-job training within three years and recently received their certificates.

An HVAC journeyman is a skilled technician specializing in the installation, maintenance, and repair of HVAC systems. Their responsibilities include evaluating the HVAC requirements and constraints of a facility, making informed recommendations, installing new systems, repairing existing ones, and performing routine regular maintenance to keep systems working efficiently.

"This certification represents a significant milestone for our team," said Glenn Leon Guerrero, Director of Facilities Management and Services. "The expertise that Bert, Tom, and Paul have gained will greatly enhance our ability to maintain and improve our campus HVAC systems, ensuring a comfortable and efficient learning environment for our students, faculty, and staff."

The certifications were earned as part of a program with the GCA Trades Academy, which aims to develop skilled technicians in HVAC, plumbing, electrical, carpentry, and construction management.
