- Required Preparation Period: May 22-26, 2023 (3 hours per day)
- Study Abroad Dates: July 3-16, 2023

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Undergraduate students at UOG (Earn 1 to 3 credits for AL-490, AL-494, or AL-498)
- Graduate students at UOG (Earn 1 to 3 credits for AL-690)

ESTIMATED COST

\$2,200 for airfare, lodging, ground transportation, meals, and cultural activities. Tuition charged separately. Scholarships will be awarded to 10 students to cover the program cost. Indicate your interest on the application form. Undergraduate agriculture majors and graduate students in the SAFNR program have scholarship priority.
