NAWIC GUAM SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM 2024

Scholarship Program Overview

NAWIC Guam Scholarship Program aims to offer financial support to students' pursuing advance degrees in construction-related degree programs, such as but not limited to architecture and engineering and trade certifications and to encourage them to define career goals in the construction industry.

This year the program will award a \$1,000 scholarship to four (4) eligible students.

Eligibility

Candidates for the NAWIC Guam Scholarship Program must:

- ✓ Be a United States citizen, permanent resident, or citizens of the Republic of Palau, Federated States of Micronesia, or Republic of the Marshall Islands.
- ✓ Be a full-time student enrolled in the University of Guam, Guam Community College or GCA Trades Academy and will also be registered for the following school year.
- ✓ Have a declared major in architecture, engineering or construction trade (to include the pre-engineering program).
- ✓ Have a cumulative GPA of 3.0 or higher on a 4.0 scale (or equivalent on a 5.0 scale).

Application Process

Candidates must submit the following:

- ✓ A completed application form.
- ✓ Academic advisor's name, phone number, and e-mail address.
- ✓ 500 word essay indicating how earning your degree or trade certification will help you achieve your goals and how it can help you improve your community
- ✓ An unofficial transcript of your academic record showing your cumulative GPA. Please note that NAWIC Guam will confirm your GPA prior to scholarship award.

About NAWIC

The National Association of Women in Construction (NAWIC) originally began as Women in Construction of Fort Worth, Texas. Sixteen women working in the construction industry founded it in 1953. Knowing that women represented only a small fraction of the construction industry, the founders organized NAWIC to create a support network. Women in Construction of Fort Worth was so successful that it gained its national charter in 1955. NAWIC Guam Chapter chartered in March 2012. NAWIC Guam provides its members with opportunities for professional development, education, networking, leadership training, public service and more. NAWIC Guam strives to encourage and develop the next generation of construction professionals and over the last 10 years has awarded close to \$50,000 in scholarships.

- Application DEADLINE: June 28, 2024
- The NAWIC Scholarship Committee will accept and review submitted scholarship applications and provide recommendation for the four awardees.
- NAWIC Guam scholarship committee will approve the final awardees.
- NAWIC Guam will announce and award scholarship to the scholarship recipients.
- Ceremony will be held in July 16, 2024 during NAWIC Guam's General Membership Meeting.

The scholarship recipients will be invited to attend the membership meeting to learn from and network with the community and industry leaders
