

Am I Eligible?

Eligibility Criteria:

- U.S. Citizen or meets the residency requirements for Federal student financial aid.
- Enrolled or accepted to UOG.
- Demonstrate an Academic Need.

And meet any of the following:

- First generation college student (neither parent nor legal guardian received a baccalaureate degree).
- Low-income based on federal guidelines.
- Student with disability (physical and/or learning.)

How Do I Apply?

- Pick up an application at the TRiO SSS Office **OR**

- Complete and submit application with supporting documents
- Applications are reviewed to determine eligibility
- Eligible applicants will be contacted for interview and services will follow as needed.
