SCHOLARSHIP OPPORTUNITIES IN THE NATURAL SCIENCES, MATHEMATICS, AND ENGINEERING

The Goldwater Scholarship supports outstanding students interested in research careers in the natural sciences, mathematics, and engineering. The scholarship covers undergraduate eligible expenses for tuition, fees, books, and room and board up to \$7,500 per academic year for up to 2 years.

ELIGIBILITY

To be considered for nomination, a student must:

- Have a minimum of one semester and no more than two years of undergraduate study remaining beginning September 2021.
- Be pursuing a bachelor's degree on a full-time basis*.
- Have an average GPA > 3.0 on a 4.0 scale.
- Be a U.S. citizen or permanent resident.
- Have a demonstrated interest in a research career in the natural sciences, mathematics, or engineering.
- Be nominated by his or her college or university via the official online nomination application.

*As a result of COVID-19, some students may not be enrolled full-time during the 2020-2021 academic year. Schools may nominate these students as part of the 2021 Goldwater competition.

NOMINATION PERIOD

First Tuesday in September through 5:00 p.m., CT on the last Friday in January.
